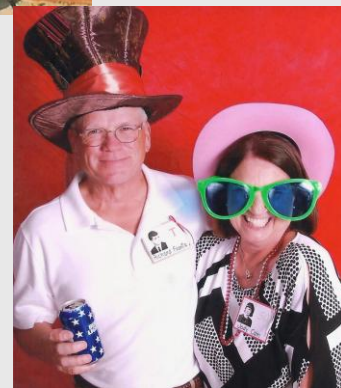

At Graduation, They Are Trojans

It may be "just a piece of paper between two pieces of cardboard" to some, but to most brand-new Troy High School graduates, the diploma is the end-and-beginning. The class of 1966 received their diplomas at last night's commencement at Hobart Arena. Not only diplomas, but speeches, awards and congratulations were given to the 298 members.

Rev. Arthur C. Decker of First United Church of Christ gave the invocation after the class came in to "Pomp and Circumstance," played by Frances Miles.

In her salutatory address, Elaine Hunt stressed the unique quality of individuality and urged her classmates to "develop it to the utmost potential."

Valedictorian Kathryn Swigart said that to one is free from authority.

No matter how much students protest, she added, they "must learn how to live with authority."

A piano solo, "Brahms' Rhapsody in G Minor," by Sandra Hartley provided a break in the speaking.

James Welburn began the awards presentation by naming Yvonne D. Smitley and Sharon Lovejoy as the recipients of the Faculty Scholarships to Miami University.

The Key Club Scholarship, announced Jay W. Holcomb, was for Marilyn Braun, and that of the Senior Boys' Club for Barbara Curry, announced William Farrell.

Mrs. Job Mitchell Jr. presented the P.T.A. Scholarship Award to Patricia Katzenberger.

Rita Lutz received two, the Miami County Medical Auxiliary Scholarship as given by Mrs. Kenneth Faze,

and the Troy Junior Altrurian Club Nursing Award, given by Mrs. Dale Sayre.

Principal Howard Hoffman told of the Class of 1965 Scholarships, which continued the precedent set by the Class of 1964. Recipients this year were Elaine Hunt and Everette Leadingham.

The Troy Business and Professional Women's Scholarship went to Suzanne Cram, and was announced by Mrs. Alva Estey.

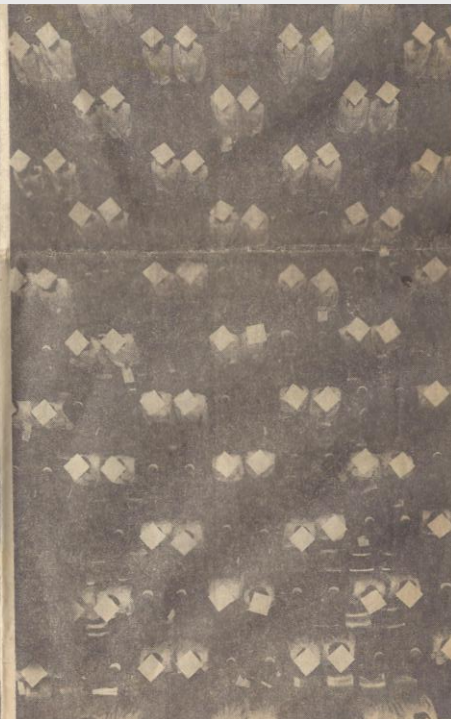
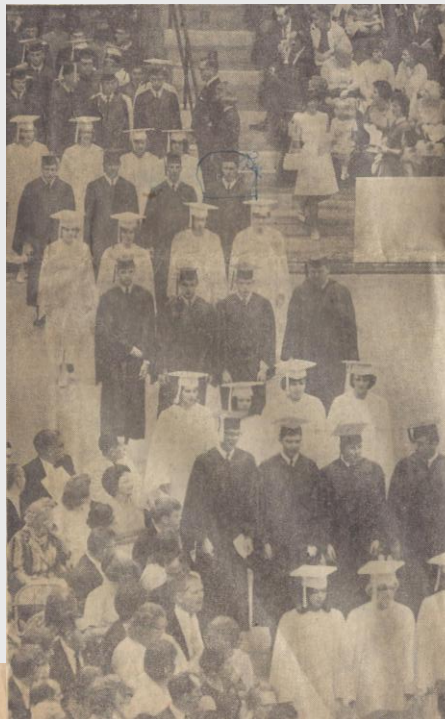
Howard Hoffman, in formally presenting the class for graduation, told them to be honest, loyal and respectful. "Put forth effort in everything you set out to do," he said.
